APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- 1) The applicant must be between the ages of seventeen (17) and twenty-one (21).
- 2) The applicant can only receive The Legacy Chorale Vocal Music Scholarship one time.
- 3) The recipient of The Legacy Chorale Vocal Music Scholarship must participate in a collegiate choral/vocal performance group.
- 4) You do NOT need to major or minor in music in college to receive The Legacy Chorale Vocal Music Scholarship.
- 5) The Legacy Chorale Vocal Music Scholarship is open to vocalists only.
- 6) The applicant must be participating currently in music classes, performance groups, or musical theatre.
- 7) One (1) or two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$500 each may be given.
- 8) The funds received from The Legacy Chorale Vocal Music Scholarship must be used for the following:
 - *Private lessons at or prior to attending college, or
 - *College tuition, or
 - *Music books (collegiate level; for lessons, music class, etc.).
- 9) Your community/school district must be represented by a member of The Legacy Chorale of Greater Minnesota; or, if your music teacher sings in The Legacy Chorale of Greater Minnesota, but does not reside in your community, you are still eligible to apply for The Legacy Chorale Vocal Music Scholarship. For the academic year 2019-20, these communities/school districts include: Aitkin, Backus, Baxter, Brainerd, Breezy Point, Crosby, Crosslake, Deerwood, East Gull Lake, Emily, Garrison, Hackensack, Ironton, Isle, Little Falls, Longville, Merrifield, Nisswa, Pequot Lakes, Pillager, Pine River and Staples.
- 10) Attached is a recommendation form for your music teacher to complete. You should either bring it along to your audition or ask that it be mailed to us. **If we do not receive your recommendation form, your application will be incomplete and will not be considered for scholarship.** You may duplicate this recommendation form for additional music teachers if you are involved in more than one musical ensemble or if you take lessons.

After we receive your application, a member of the scholarship committee will call you to arrange a April 25, 2020 audition time. If you cannot audition on April 25, 2020, we will do our best to accommodate your schedule.

Each applicant will have twenty (20) minutes for their audition, and each audition will include a performance, and a personal interview with the applicant and the scholarship committee.

Repertoire:

* Your audition piece must be no longer than five (5) minutes in length.
* Repertoire must be similar to that accepted at contest, but can also include folk songs and selections from opera, operetta, and musical theatre.

*Repertoire MUST NOT be of the “Pop” style – no “American Idol” repertoire!!

Accompaniment:

*You must have an accompanist, either your own or a taped accompaniment.
**(Due to the pandemic COVID-19 situation, we are allowing taped accompaniment)*
